Living Water is a homeschool cooperative that provides a Christ-centered environment to support parent-directed education. Our organization meets one day per week, with classes ranging from Nursery to High School. Our focus is primarily school-aged children in Kindergarten and higher, however, we provide nursery, toddler and preschool classes for younger children. Each class is led by the parents themselves and offers numerous extra-curricular activities to help children grow throughout the year. Beyond the designation of homeschool cooperative, we want Living Water to be a ministry to the children and parents. We want the fellowship with other homeschool parents and the structure of a formal organization to be a blessing to everyone involved.

What is Living Water?

- The Living Water Cooperative (Co-op) provides extracurricular classes for homeschoolers in a Christ-centered environment to support parent-directed education.
- Parents lead and teach classes, coordinate events and provide opportunities for children to grow and learn through unique and exciting experiences.
- Living Water Co-op is a parent-led and run co-op. Each family is responsible to participate in the co-op every week.
- Each family will have an opportunity to contribute in a different area each session. These areas could include: Art, Music, Physical Education, Teacher Assistants, Nursery Teachers, Preschool Teachers, Substitutes, Coordinators, Hall Monitors, and more.
- Living Water offers resources for Nursery through High School children one day a week.
- If you are a new or seasoned homeschool parent who would like to provide extracurricular activities to your homeschool education, or think that your child would benefit from fellowship with other Christians in an educational environment. Living Water is here for you.

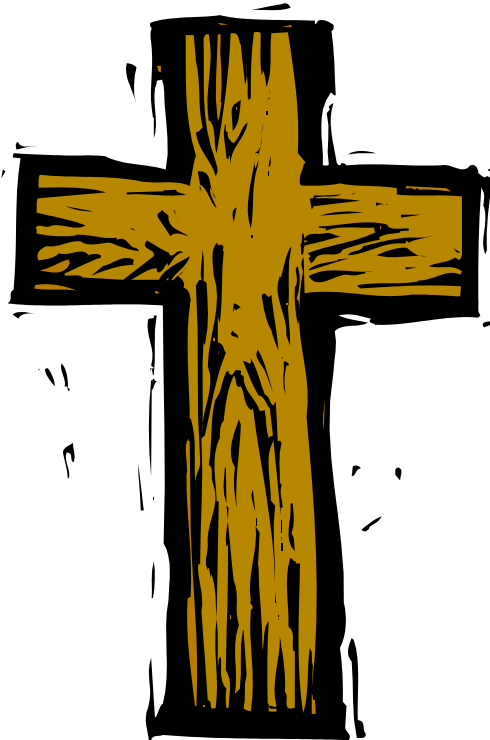
Statement of Faith

Living Water Policies



Please carefully read the following policies.

New Membership Policy

Anyone desiring to become a part of the Living Water Homeschool should contact us via phone or email. Note: The oldest child in your family attending should be at least 5 years old by December.

Procedures:

1. Please read the Living Water Handbook, then complete and submit the registration form online.
2. A phone interview will be coordinated to answer any questions from the prospective member.
3. Families may only join at the beginning of the sessions. This helps maintain scheduling and class consistency.

Attendance Policy

Attendance is important to a consistent and effective program. Our parent-leaders and their children should make every effort to be on-time and present for every class. If an unexpected circumstance arises, please contact the Substitute Coordinator as soon as possible to facilitate the scheduling of a substitute teacher. We allow 3 unexcused absences per year.

Illness Policy

If you or your children have experienced a fever, vomiting, diarrhea, or any other contagious illness with 48 hours of scheduled activities, please stay home. Also, please contact the Substitute Coordinator as soon as possible to facilitate the scheduling of a substitute teacher and to submit a prayer request.

Guest Policy

We encourage guests to attend a weekly session with your family. Please make them aware of our Statement of Faith and Core Values. As with all of our children, we do request that the guest's parent or guardian remains onsite during the visit in case of an emergency or special requirement.

Supply Policy

We attempt to provide some very basic resources for the weekly classes. These items may be insufficient for a complete lesson; therefore, please be prepared to bring your own materials.

Dress Policy

Living Water t-shirts should be worn to co-op each week. Children should bring or wear tennis shoes and loose comfortable clothing for Physical Education Class.

Privacy Policy

We desire our homeschool to be a safe environment for our members. Everyone should respect the privacy of our families. We will not release names, phone numbers, or any personal information of any member to any third-party without the express permission of that member. Please let us know if you would not like your information on the Living Water Contact List that is distributed to Living Water families.

Liability and Medical Release Policy

All member families agree and understand that neither the co-op, its members, nor the facility ownership are liable for any injuries incurred during co-op events.

Discipline Policy

To maintain a safe and harmonious environment, we ask that all parents consistently enforce the discipline policy. Please lead the children to respect those in charge, respect others, and respect our facilities. "Do unto others, as you would have them do unto you." Matthew 7:12, Luke 6:31

Procedure: 3-Count Discipline Program

1. 1st count is a warning
2. 2nd count is separation from the group and activities until the child agrees to co-operate
3. 3rd count, the child will be removed from co-op activities and placed with their parent for the remainder of the day. If the parent is teaching, then a substitute will be brought-in to teach the remainder of the class.

Treat Policy

Due to allergies and personal preferences, we must discourage the distribution of candy. However, you may bring stickers or other types of rewards for the children in your classes.

Family Policy

We encourage both husbands and wives to take part in Living Water. Although our courses will be primarily lead by stay-at-home moms, we encourage the fathers to understand and support Living Water's core values.

Faculty Positions for Co-op Classes

Each family will have a different responsibility for each session, including: Art, Music, PE, Special Topic Teachers and Teacher Assistants; Nursery Teachers and Assistants; Preschool/Toddler Teachers and Assistants; Class Manager; Snack Coordinator, Hall Monitor; Clean Up Coordinator; Registration and Dismissal Supervisor; and Substitute. The Faculty Positions Interest Form will be emailed to you shortly after you register.

Art, Music, PE, and Special Topic Teachers

- Work with coordinator to develop weekly lessons for the session.
- Create one substitute lesson and turn in to the curriculum chairperson by the first day of the session. (Just in case you are out, so we will have a plan).
- Facilitates and manages classroom activities for specific age groups.
- Teachers are responsible for setting up their room and returning their classrooms to the specification of the facility.
- Teachers are responsible for working with the coordinators regarding the subject matter to be taught. Subject matter being taught will follow the statement of faith and not contradict it.

Teacher Assistant

- Assists the teachers during the class.

Preschool/Toddler Teachers

- The preschool teacher will work with the preschool director to design a fun class using the current preschool topics.

Preschool/Toddler Teacher Assistant

- Assists the teachers during the class.

Nursery Teacher

- Works with nursery director to plan fun activities, and creates a safe environment and for our little ones to play.

Nursery Teacher Assistant

- Assists the nursery teacher during the class.

Class Manager

- Lead the children to their classrooms when classes change and help supervise bathroom breaks.
- Expected to stay with the class at all times.

Snack Coordinator

- Prepares snack for nursery – preschool at co-op each week.
- Prepares treats, coffee/tea for mommies during co-op breaks.

Hall Monitor

- Hall monitor needs to routinely check all classrooms and halls and assist with transition times and bathroom breaks.

Clean up Coordinator

- Ensures all rooms are cleaned and trash is removed.

Registration and Dismissal Supervisor

- Provides fun activities (stories, quiet games) for children before and after co-op.

Substitute

- Available to substitute if a regularly scheduled person is unable to attend.

Living Water Leadership

The President oversees all Living Water leaders and events. The President, Vice-President, Treasurer, and Curriculum Chairperson serve in their respective areas to coordinate the schedule, handle the financial obligations and costs, and to function as general managers of the co-op. Together with our spouses, we will make a commitment to create a Christ-centered cooperative group.

If you are interested in becoming involved in the administration of Living Water, please read the positions below and prayerfully consider where you would like to serve.

Administration Positions (Long Term One-Year Positions)

Art, Music, and Physical Education Curriculum Developers

- Develops curriculum objectives and topics for the entire school year.
- Submits the curriculum objectives and topics to the curriculum chairperson.
- Assists teachers when creating their class lessons, if needed.

Special Topic Curriculum Developer

- Parents contribute their expertise in area such as a foreign language, sewing, or other educational topics with specialized knowledge in that area.
- Teaches the special class or provides other teachers with the information needed to teach this special topic.

Field Trip Coordinator

- Searches out exciting field trips that align with class topics and are appropriate for all ages.
- Advertises and coordinates field trips, which includes providing directions and information on any fees, if applicable.

Merchandizing Coordinator

- Designs, orders, and distributes t-shirts to members throughout the year.
- Design and coordinate other Living Water merchandizing materials such as hats, pens, bumper stickers, and coffee mugs.

Nursery and Preschool Director

- Develops a daily schedule for all nursery, toddler, and preschool classes.
- Plans topics and learning goals for the entire school year.

Prayer Leader

- Organizes prayer times and prays regularly for our children, the needs of our families, and any other prayer requests.

Celebration Planner

- Organizes and plans special fun events, such as a Christmas party, Valentine's Party, holiday events, graduation, and monthly birthday celebrations.

God's World News Distributor

- Coordinates and distributes *God's World News* Magazines to members.

Field Day Planner

- Organizes and oversees the Living Water Field Day in the spring.
